BOIL WATER NOTICE

Date: April 29, 2026

Attention Hubbard City Water Customer,

Due to a water main break within the system that resulted in a loss of water pressure, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required the City of Hubbard public water system to notify all customers to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure the destruction of harmful bacteria and other microbes, all water intended for drinking, cooking, or ice making should be brought to a vigorous rolling boil and maintained for a minimum of two (2) minutes. The water should then be allowed to cool prior to use. As an alternative, customers may choose to use bottled water from an approved source.

This boil water notice will remain in effect until laboratory testing confirms that the water is safe for consumption. Notification will be provided on the City of Hubbard website once the notice has been lifted. At this time, test results are anticipated to be available by the afternoon of May 1st, 2026.
